- 4) Old Business:
 - Ramp gates Steve told members that the Ramp gates installation has been completed with 27 in place in all East and West areas. Some discussion re: handicap access. One gate is in storage.
 - b. Blue Ridge Shortcut mastication is in progress. Any trail work will need to be on hold until that project is completed which covers 280 acres.

 - b. "Take a Hike" trail guidebooks are available for purchase at Nature Center. A newer edition will be out in October, which will also be online.
 - c. Lynn reminded volunteers for Charlie Clark's will not have to pay admission.
 - d. Arlene announced the theme of this year's parade is "Fall in Love with Arizona's White Mountains." She will need help decorating TRACKS entry. Come to Nature Center on 9/19 at 10 am. The parade starts at 10 am on Saturday, Sept. 23. TRACKS will incorporate "Leave No Trace" in the entry.
